Dear Friends,

It reads in the Scriptures that, "You are a priest forever in the order of Melchizedek of old!" I am sorry to inform you of the death of Father John F. Mooney, a priest of the Diocese of Saint John, who would have been 92 on May 29th and ordained for 65 years on June 3rd. Father John died peacefully on Palliative Care at the Saint John Regional. After his retirement, he came to St. Rose of Lima in 2000 as a priest in residence. He will be sorely missed by our own parishioners and the parishioners of the many parishes he served.

As you know, Father Mooney's health has been declining since his fall last year and along with a severe weight loss and mobility issues, he was diagnosed recently with bone cancer. It was never a wish of his to go to a nursing home so I am glad we were able to accommodate him until his most recent fall at the Rectory and subsequent admittance to Palliative Care.

We mourn this weekend a great presbyter and man who touched the hearts of many over his years of ministry. Father John was a man of prayer and lived the Gospel in ordinary ways. He would find Christ in everyday things, whether it was practicing judo, building airplanes or telling stories of when he was a young priest.

Father Mooney just enjoyed real life. He wasn't a preachy kind of person and he lived the Gospel in his own life by the way that he lived.

Father Mooney's funeral will be held on Monday, May 11, 2015 at the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception at 12:05 p.m. Visitation will be at the Cathedral Rectory from 7-9 p.m. Saturday and Sunday 2-4 p.m. with Solemn Vespers at 7p.m. Sunday followed by visitation until 9 p.m.
