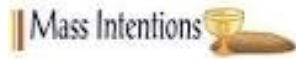

<p>My Friends, Hope you noticed the new parking lines in our parking lot. It really defines our space and enhances our property. As well, we are upgrading the wheelchair ramp to enable our parishioners who need it to have easier accessibility to our faith community. Our third area to work on is restoring our steeple, this summer. As I conclude my time as your Pastor I want to leave our Church in the best possible condition for my successor. During my time we have put on a new roof, painted the exterior of the Church, and refurbished the interior with new flooring. St. Rose of Lima is a beautiful Parish and we have a beautiful Church. Having said all that, these improvements are expensive but worth it. I want to give you some facts to consider as we move forward: 1) Each month we have to send our Diocesan Assessment to Chancery, which is \$3300 or approximately one week's collection 2) Lawn Care and Snow Removal and Church Cleaning is \$3200</p>	<p>a month, every month of the year c) Heating for March alone was \$3700. So you can see all our ongoing expenses are quite high and we should be bringing in \$5000 a week to be able to operate our Church without having to touch our investments. For the revitalization/realignment of our Diocese, every Parish needs to demonstrate that they are solvent/self-sufficient. I want this Parish to be here for a long, long time but we need your support and commitment to demonstrate this. I encourage those who are able to help make this a viable Parish. Thank you for your generosity. We need your stewardship. One last thought: lunch at any fast food place is \$10 or more. Perhaps if we all gave up 1 lunch for the Parish, we could reach the \$5000 we need each week. Blessings Father Gerry P.S.: This is my first and last time to write about money but I need you to know where we stand.</p>
